The services we offer have developed over time to reflect social changes, but our purpose remains to help people in desperate need. After taking care of your loved ones, the simplest way to leave a gift in your will to the Auckland City Mission is to speak with your solicitor. He or she can ensure that your estate is distributed in a way that honors your wishes.

Your gift can be:

Residuary: A percentage of your estate after loved ones are taken care of, specific gifts and expenses have been settled.

Pecuniary: This is a gift in the form of a specified amount of money.

Specific: A particular item of property or stocks and shares.

You may also specify your gift is left to The Auckland City Mission Foundation, established in 2004 with the objective of being a permanent fund to provide the Mission with a consistent income in support of our vital services (registration number: CC22964).
